

Thank you for your interest in participating with a poster or talk in the 16th IOC to be held in Lima, Peru from the 24th to the 28th of February 2025. Following are the instructions to submit your abstract to the given email. Please do so at your earliest convenience.

## 16th IOC abstract instructions - how to submit your abstract for review

- 1) The abstract must be produced in English.
- 2) The <u>body</u> of the summary should include a maximum of 300 words, with 2.5 cm margins on each side, and the text justified. Use Times New Roman font, 12-point size, single-spaced. After each period, leave a space (the program to use will be Word, in .doc or .docx format).
- 3) The <u>title</u> should appear at the top, centered, in bold uppercase and without a period. It should not exceed 20 words.
- 4) On a new line, <u>list the author(s)</u>, first, the given name(s) followed by the last name(s) in bold, separated by commas, and before the last author, include the word "and." The names should be centered, in both uppercase and lowercase. The authors' names should begin with the given name followed by the last name(s). They should have a superscript number indicating the corresponding institution, with the presenter marked with an asterisk.
- 5) On a new line, mention the <u>affiliation(s)</u>, the full name of the area, department or institution, and country, separated by commas and ending with a period. Include the email address of the main author or presenter, followed by the author's initials in parentheses.
- 6) <u>Session number</u> (choose between: 1 Education, Communication and Networking; 2 Advance Techniques for Otter Monitoring; 3 Red and Green List Assessment; 4 Threats and Coexistence; 5 Conservation Planning; 6 Ex-Situ)
- 7) We will answer confirming the receipt of your proposal and the next steps to take. If we do not answer, we have not received your proposal.
